

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

In making this application, I understand and agree that:

- All memberships are subject to the approval of the management of the GW Tennis Center
- No member may sell or transfer his/her membership.
- Membership fees are non-refundable.
- Membership fees, professional instruction fees, and other charges incurred by the member and his or her family and guests in the use of the Club are nonrefundable and subject to change (such charges and fees will not be applied retroactively).
- Members(CARD) and Students(GWORLD) are asked to have their ID at all times. Students will be required to give ID when reserving courts and for demo racquets. Valid sticker is required.
- As a courtesy to the club and its members, all members and guests must wear proper tennis attire and non-marking tennis shoes at all times.
- Members are responsible for their guest's attire; juniors are subject to the same rules.
- Reminder - a club member must be physically present while a guest is using the club
- All players must check in at the front desk prior to going onto the court.
- The guest fee is \$10 per person per day. Guests are allowed at the club once per month.
- Be courteous of others when entering and leaving the courts.
- Court reservations may be made up to one week in advance by members.
- Reservations will be allowed for one hour and a half of singles and two hours for doubles; in addition, each member will only be allowed to reserve a court once/day. If courts are available, members are permitted to continue playing past the time limit; however, they will have to vacate the court once it has been requested by another member.
- Members can reserve courts online or by calling the front desk. Confirmations will be sent to members if they leave a message. Do not assume court is reserved until you receive a call back.
- Members may reserve courts before opening and after closing hours. Reservations must be made 24 hours in advance for this service by phone.
- After closing hours, students may bump members if all courts are taken.
- Tennis Pro/Tennis Staff must be present for members to use the tennis facility.
- Drinking alcoholic beverages and smoking at the GW tennis center is strictly prohibited.
- Each member is asked to help keep the club clean by picking up and discarding trash.
- No events should be planned on the GW courts without director's approval; 4 weeks advance notice is required.
- Do not confront other members or guests if there are rule violations; please alert the manager or tennis director
- The GW tennis center is not responsible for lost, stolen or misplaced articles anywhere on the club premises.
- Members may borrow locker keys while at the club free of charge.
- Students may play on open courts if no reservations are made. They will be allowed to play until the end of each hour before a member can take their court.
- Do not use the courts after rain unless permitted by manager or director.
- Proper court etiquette and behavior is required of all members and guests at all time.
- There is no teaching at the GW Tennis Center unless prior approval is given by Greg Munoz, Tennis Director
- Non-Member court rental is available for \$10 per person per hour.
- Faculty/Alumni may purchase membership or may rent the courts for \$10/person/day.
- Faculty/Parents of current GW students may use the club for free while playing with GW students.
- Ball machine rental is \$20 plus court fee.
- The management reserves the right to alter or add to these regulations as may appear advisable in the future.
